

SENIOR YEAR TIMELINE



NOVEMBER - DECEMBER

Submit early decision/early action applications.

Discuss how you will pay for college with your parents.

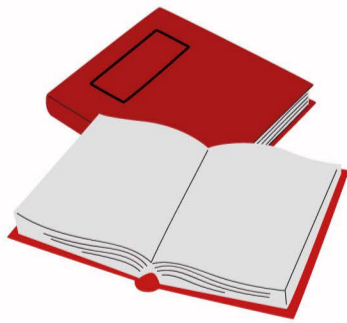


FEBRUARY - MARCH

Celebrate your acceptances!

College visits.

Avoid senioritis! Colleges will ask for a final transcript and monitor senior year grades.



MAY

Deposits are due May 1st.



JULY - AUGUST

Finalize college list.

Write college essay.

Fill out college applications.

SEPTEMBER - OCTOBER

Study! Colleges ask to see quarter 1 grades.

Attend information sessions of the college admissions counselors that visit your high school.

Discuss your counselor letter of recommendation with your school counselor.

Ask two teachers for letters of recommendation.

Retake SAT/ACT, if necessary.

Visit colleges.

Complete financial aid forms. (FAFSA is available Oct. 1st.)



JANUARY

Submit regular decision applications.

Check the portal for each college to make sure all applications are complete.

Apply for "local scholarships" through your high school.



APRIL

Review financial aid packages.

Attend "Accepted Students Days" at colleges.

Make a final decision.

JUNE

Celebrate Graduation!
